1 **TO THE HONORABLE KATHERINE BACAL, JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT:**

2 On February 22, 2019, the Court entered an order granting preliminary approval of the class action
3 settlement. The Court set a Final Fairness Hearing for July 12, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in Department C-69. In
